THE OG ORIGINALS NOW LEADING THE CHARGE

These are the winemakers at the forefront of the Grower Champagne "movement." I air-quotes movement because the tides were turning long before the wines ever got much recognition. They were first to the US market and almost all of them make wine for multi-generational wineries. The vineyards have been passed down through the family and the current winemakers really took it upon themselves to question why and how their families had made Champagne before them. Some continue the traditions but with a more thoughtful approach, others have changed style, technique, and practices. Respect and obsession has only grown for these wines, making them some of the most sought after in the world.



Here's a curated selection of the winemakers making waves, young guys pushing the limits of Champagne with a deep understanding of terroir. Each of


these winemakers work a portion of their family's land, which has been passed down through generations. Some of them didn't think they would become




