## SERVES 1

3 ounces Grey Goose  
orange-flavored vodka

½ orange

2 ounces La Croix orange-  
flavored sparkling water

1 large ice cube

1 slice orange

1 sprig fresh mint

Add vodka to a cocktail shaker filled with ice. Squeeze the juice from the orange into the vodka. Shake hard for 30 seconds. Add sparkling water and shake one more time. Strain into a balloon glass filled with one large ice cube. Garnish with the orange slice and mint sprig. Serve with a sterling silver straw.
